

Resume CTE from latest Threshold state.

Current Threshold core:

Threshold = external / experience without awareness

Witness = awareness of experience

Working Threshold order:

In Noise

Surviving the Day

While I Was Away

City Symphony = locked Witness opener / observer initiation

Current Threshold development notes:

In Noise functions as primer / creator-entry / process introduction

Surviving the Day = routine mistaken for living

While I Was Away = sensory re-entry / changed-world recognition

Songs must be placed by experienced meaning, not lyric meaning alone

Do not let Threshold become too self-aware too early

Current song in development: Tribal
Threshold version derived from the deeper
Witness-scale pattern in The Absurdity of It.

Goal:

- strip the broader worldview down into
sports/crowd tribal experience

- keep it external

- keep it chant-like, raw, fragmented, and
lived inside

- always use us against them, never “us
and them”

- preserve image-language like clowns
wearing crowns

- avoid turning it into commentary from
above
